- **Day and Time: Mondays** afterschool from **2:30 - 3:30pm**.
- **Dates:** Spring semester from **January 28 to April 1**.
- **Who can play:** Chess is open to any student in 2nd grade and older. Younger children may join only if they know how the pieces move and capture. There must be at least 10 registered for the class to make.
